learn about bowen theory the bowen center for the study of Aug 19 2021 dr murray bowen a psychiatrist originated his theory and its eight interlocking concepts he formulated the theory by using systems thinking to integrate knowledge of the human as a product of evolution with knowledge from family research a core assumption is that an emotional system that evolved over several billion years governs human
